A WORD

We are deeply saddened by your loss. As a congregation, we pray that your wounds will be healed by time and with the knowledge that your friends stand beside you ready to ease your pain: In your moment of grief, we are with you.

This booklet comes with the hope that the many directions of mourning will become clearer, more comprehensible. From the first stages of mourning until Yizkor, the ancient Jewish laws and customs are laid out here; everything you need to know about the bereavement process.

The Jewish customs which surround death involve two basic concepts:

1) Honoring the dead and 2) Coming to terms with the loss so that life might continue. You will find that all of the laws and practices which follow come under one of these categories- honoring and healing. Psychologists and religious folk laud the Jewish practices of mourning as they seek to find meaning from the end of life.

You are an integral part of our Beth Shalom Synagogue family. As such, the congregation and I are here ready to support you.

May the Holy one, blessed be He, grant long life to your loved ones. As the days and weeks pass, may God give you strength, courage and comfort from the rich, warm memories you possess.

Mourner's Kaddish

Glorified and hallowed be the great name of God throughout the world which was created according to Divine will. May the rule of peace be established speedily in our time, unto us and unto the entire household of Israel. Amen.

May God's great name be praised throughout all eternity. Extolled and glorified, honored and adored, ever be the name of the Holy One. God is beyond the praises and hymns of glory which mortals offer throughout the world. Amen.

May there be a great heavenly peace and life unto us, unto all Israel. Amen.

May the One who ordains the harmony of the universe, bestow peace upon us and upon the whole house of Israel. Amen. This section of the guide is to help you through the process of visiting the dead and honoring them.

Bring this booklet with you whenever you visit the cemetery. It contains the necessary prayers of remembrance.

In keeping the memory of the dead, alive, we honor their lives, contributions, and legacy.

Here are some reminders of what we do when we visit a cemetery.

- 1. It is not appropriate to visit the Jewish cemetery on Shabbat or holy days.
- 2. When leaving the monument, we leave small pebbles on it as an eternal reminder of our unfading love and devotion.
- 3. Wash our hands when leaving the cemetery.

On the actual yahrzeit we light a memorial candle, give tzedakah, and attend minyan at Synagogue.

Note: The Kaddish we only say with a minyan (ten Jewish adults.)
