_____ Adult Education Committee - Plan and promote and bring programs of educational and cultural interest to our synagogue.

_____ Building & Grounds Committee - This committee shall supervise and direct the proper maintenance of congregational property. The committee shall also prescribe rules and regulations as to the use of the buildings and fees, if any, to be charged for said use.

<u>Cemetery Committee</u> - This committee shall have charge of the cemeteries belonging to this Congregation and shall provide for their care in a suitable manner. Only individuals of the Jewish faith may be buried in the Beth Shalom Cemeteries.

_____ Chevra Kadisha Committee - This committee shall make appropriate burial preparations.

_____ Fundraising Committee- This committee shall be responsible for the fundraising activities of the congregation and shall plan and carry out such activities to meet the financial obligations of the congregation.

_____ Library Committee - Maintains our library and catalogs new books.

_____ Membership & Goodwill Committee - This committee shall be charged with the responsibility of being in contact with Jewish families in the community which are not affiliated with any congregation, particularly with new families, with the view of inviting them to become members of the congregation.

_____ Outreach Hesed Committee - Reach out to those who are bedridden or may need assistance keeping in touch with the community. Visit the sick and whoever may need some special attention.

_____ Ritual Committee - Formulates rules and regulations compatible with Conservative Judaism for all services.

_____ Safe Team Committee - This committee is committed to the safe environment of the synagogue on Shabbat.

_____ Social Action Committee - In the spirit of Tikkun Olam, Hebrew for "repairing the world," the Social Action Committee develops programming designed to heighten awareness of social problems within our community, the nation, and the world.

_____ Social Committee - This committee shall be charged with the responsibility of developing a year-round program of social activities aimed at furthering fellowship and sociability among members of the Congregation. It shall also have the responsibility of arranging for appropriate programs for the various events which it may sponsor.
